FLOATING NUCLEAR PLANTS: FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT, PART III (NUREG-0502, DECEMBER 1978)

Enclosed for your information is Part III of the Final Environmental Statement which provides a comparison of risks from the accidental releases of radioactivity to the environment for floating and land-based nuclear power plants.

The FES also presents an integrated cost-benefit analysis for the floating nuclear plant concept and reflects on a cumulative basis, the elements of review in Parts I, II, and III. This portion of the Final Environmental Statement was prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the U. S.
