REQUEST FOR INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL

I hereby request the Chairman of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to certify an interlocutory appeal to the Commission with respect to certain of the determinations made in the Board's MEMORANDUM AND ORDER of October 10, 1979.¹

Specifically, I request that the following two matters be referred to the full Commission:

1. Should Congressman Dellums be admitted to participate in the proceedings on the basis of his representative status as well as his personal status?
2. May Congressman Dellums be represented in the proceedings by staff members not admitted to practice before a federal or state bar?

The ASLB's adverse determinations on these two questions seriously impinges upon my ability to participate in these proceedings and, therefore, should be reviewed at the earliest practicable moment by the Commission. The public interest in the early determination of this question warrants its certification to the Commission.


