This refers to the special inspection conducted by Ms. M. Campbell of this office on May 22, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-16721-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Ms. Campbell with Dr. Crawford and Dr. Walsh of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a review of your activities regarding disposal of licensed material. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures, interviews with personnel, measurements by the inspector, and observations by the inspector. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

From the discussions conducted during the inspection, it is our understanding that your Radiation Safety Officer will conduct an audit of your waste disposal activities to assure compliance with NRC regulations, the instructions of your waste disposal company, and your internal procedures. The results of this audit will be reviewed during a subsequent inspection of your licensed program.
