Pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.55(e) (3) and the reporting period specified in Reference C, this letter is submitted as the interim report on the potentially defective Kulka terminal blocks supplied by Conax for the drywell electrical penetrations.

Results of test investigation of the terminal blocks has been thus far inconclusive.

Within 120 days, we will issue a definitive written report if evaluation indicates a reportable deficiency. If at that time, we determine it not to be reportable under 10 CFR 50.55(e), we will notify your office.
