## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Based on the results of an NRC inspection conducted on February 8, 1979, it appears that one of your activities was not in full compliance with NRC regulations as indicated below:

A. 10 CFR 30.41(c) requires that prior to transferring licensed material, you must verify that the transferees' license authorizes the receipt of the type, form and quantity of the by-product material to be transferred. 10 CFR 30.41(d) specifies acceptable methods for verification required by paragraph (c), and states in Section (1) that an acceptable method is that the transferrer may have in his possession, and read, a current copy of the transferees' specific license, or registration certificate, and states in Section (3) that another acceptable method for verification is that for emergency shipments the transferrer may accept oral certification by the licensee that he is authorized by license or registration certificate to receive the type, form and quantity of by-product material to be transferred, specifying the license or registration certificate number, issuing agency and expiration date: provided, that the oral certification is confirmed in writing within ten days.

Contrary to this requirement, during January 1979, you shipped Xenon-133, a licensed material, to a hospital without first verifying that the hospitals' license authorized Xenon-133.

This is an infraction.

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
