This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. F. Costello of this office on March 5, 1979, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 31-02933-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Costello with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a review of your use of licensed material in areas where the NRC has jurisdiction. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

From discussions at the conclusion of the inspection, it is our understanding that you plan to notify this office prior to performing radiographic work in a non-Agreement State. If your intent differs from our understanding, please inform this office to that effect within seven (7) days following the receipt of this letter.
