Reports to NRC have become time consuming and expensive. You require stack sampling, etc. even when you can calculate that levels of isotope couldn't be above allowed levels. This latest requirement (your April 25, 1980 letter) asking licensees to submit two reports to two different locations, is costly and inefficient for us and reflects your agency's inefficiency. Please reconsider this request.
