Ladies and Gentlemen,

This letter provides notification that Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke Energy), intends to submit a subsequent license renewal application for the Operating Licenses for Oconee Nuclear Station (ONS), Units 1, 2 and 3.

The first renewed Operating Licenses for ONS, Units 1, 2 and 3 were issued on May 23, 2000, and will expire at midnight on February 6, 2033, October 6, 2033 and July 19, 2034, respectively. Duke Energy intends to submit a Subsequent License Renewal Application (SLRA) for the renewed Operating Licenses for ONS, Units 1, 2 and 3 in accordance with 10 CFR Part 54, "Requirements for Renewal of Operating Licenses for Nuclear Power Plants," by the end of 2021.

This notification is being provided consistent with RIS 2009-06, "Importance of Giving NRC Advance Notice of Intent to Pursue License Renewal," dated June 15, 2009. As discussed in RIS 2009-006, Duke Energy will keep the NRC informed of any changes to the anticipated schedule for filing the SLRA for ONS to facilitate NRC efforts to plan for processing of license renewal applications.
