Mr. Rhoades:

In an email dated July 15, 2019 the NRC communicated to you that the State of Vermont was in the process of pursuing Agreement State status. To prepare for the transfer of authority from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to the State of Vermont we requested that you review your license and choose whether you wanted to maintain both an NRC license and a State of Vermont license or maintain only a State of Vermont license. In your email response to the NRC you elected to maintain only a State of Vermont license.

This email is to notify you that the agreement with the State of Vermont has been approved. Effective September 30, 2019, the NRC will transfer authority to the State of Vermont to regulate radioactive material use within its borders. Your NRC license will convert to a State of Vermont license as of that date. Starting on September 30, 2019 should you need to work anywhere the NRC maintains jurisdiction you will need to file for Reciprocity.

To file reciprocity for the first time in a calendar year (January- December), you must submit the following:

1. NRC Form 241, "Report of Proposed Activities in Non-Agreement States, Areas of Exclusive Federal Jurisdiction, or Offshore Waters," attached, or accessible from the NRC web site at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc241.pdf>, and
2. One copy of the Agreement State Radioactive Materials Specific License, and
3. Fee specified in Category 16, 10 CFR 170.31 (currently \$2100) by either check or credit card. If using credit card, please use NRC Form 629, accessible from the NRC web site at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc629.pdf>. The Initial Filing must be made to the NRC at least 3 days prior to conducting initial activities in a calendar year (January - December) under the General License established by 10 CFR 150.20.
