1)	Westinghouse	Reactor Coolant System	No welded pipe supplied by Youngstown Welding and Engineering Company used on this order.
2)	Stone & Webster Construction Purchase Orders	Various - Safety Related Systems - Random Spools	No welded pipe supplied by Youngstown Welding and Engineering Company used on these orders.
3)	Tubeco, Inc. (M-150)	Various - Safety Related Systems	Although substantial quantities of welded pipe from Youngstown Welding and Engineering Company has been or will be used in the fabrication of Unit 3 safety-related pipe spools, all of the material involved have had 100% x-ray of the longitudinal seam weld and therefore are considered acceptable.
4)	Southwest Fabrication and Welding Company	Various - Safety Related Systems	Still under investigation. We will report to the NRC as soon as this information is available.
