Dear Mr. Constas,

By email dated July 15, 2019, we informed you of the impending Agreement between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the State of Vermont, whereby, the NRC will relinquish regulatory authority for certain licenses of byproduct, source, and special nuclear material. We also explained that your NRC license, which authorized licensed activities in Vermont and at temporary job sites anywhere in the United States where the NRC maintains jurisdiction (non-Agreement States), required an amendment prior to the transfer. This action is necessary since authorization to conduct licensed activities at temporary job sites in NRC-regulated states will no longer be valid when Vermont assumes regulatory authority on September 30, 2019.

On July 17, 2019, you informed the NRC that you wished to continue the use of licensed material in States that are under NRC jurisdiction. Therefore, your current NRC license has been amended to remove all Vermont locations of use and/or storage, leaving all other locations (including temporary job sites, if applicable) which authorize work activities in non-Agreement States. In addition, we have issued you a new license authorizing work activities only in the State of Vermont. Enclosed with this letter are both licenses.

Please review the enclosed documents carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the licenses. If there are any errors or questions on the NRC license, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers. Errors or questions on the license authorizing licensed activities in the State of Vermont should be directed to Francis O'Neill at the Vermont Department of Health at (802) 865-7743.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
