PPG Industries, Inc. has made a written request, dated 12/7/79, to the Licensing Division of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for an amendment to its Materials License (No. 37-17727-01). We have requested the deletion of M. A. Grodin's name from Condition 12 of the License and have offered three names in its place. The licensed material will now be used under the supervision of S. F. Zdziarski, Senior Process Engineer; R. D. Ondocsin, Industrial Hygienist; and J. F. Sproull, Head - Tank Department. We expect to be in full compliance when the Licensing Division approves the amendment request.

The shared supervisory responsibility, as proposed, will afford greater management control in the proper utilization of the licensed material. In addition, a training session is scheduled to re-emphasize to the appropriate personnel the operating procedures of the unit and the applicable safety regulations. We believe that these two items will help avoid further items of noncompliance.
