The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 40 to Facility Operating License NPF-1 for the Trojan Nuclear Plant. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your request dated October 21, 1977, as supplemented August 4, 1978.

This amendment deletes meteorological instruments from the Technical Specifications that are not relied upon for the safety analysis of the facility, and makes an editorial correction to the action to be taken in the event meteorological instruments are inoperable.

Copies of the Safety Evaluation and the Notice of Issuance are also enclosed.
