This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. D. F. Kirsch, T. W. Hutson and G. Hernandez of this office on July 9-12, 1979 of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-154 and CPPR-155, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. Kirsch with Mr. C. E. Love and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.


