2. Expiration of License

The inspector contacted the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency and was informed by letter dated November 28, 1979, that the radioactive material possessed under License 37-12207-1 was picked up by them on August 16, 1979, and returned to their storage at Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania.

The inspector contacted the licensee on January 8, 1980, and verified this information. Additionally, the licensee informed the inspector that he possessed no byproduct material and wished to have his license terminated.

3. Evaluation by the Regional Office

Region I has evaluated the information supplied by the licensee and determined that a closeout survey is not necessary and that the license should be retired.
