Mr. Hutton,

Presently there are NRC hearings being held in court-room no. 2 Federal Building, Raleigh, N.C. on the Carolina Power and Light Company's ability to build and safely operate the Shearon-Harris Nuclear Power Plant. In spite of the public concern for this issue and the supposedly public input of these hearings, only the designated "intervenor" - The Conservation Council, is allowed to participate in these hearings. Having moved to within 20 miles of this plant only 1/2 yrs. ago, and not belonging to the Conservation Council, I am left without democratic input. I feel my rights of citizenship have been denied.

As I understand it, there is a proposed rule "PRM-2-7" that would ease these tedious and unfair restrictions over a matter that is of extreme health importance to me. I urge you to support this rule change and to delay these undemocratic hearings, and the plant's construction until the voice of legal residents such as myself can be properly heard.
