Dear Mr. Saltzman:

This is in reply to your letter of May 1, 1979, submitting Amendment No. 11 to Indemnity Agreement No. D-9 between the National Bureau of Standards and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for our review and acceptance. The amendment gives effect to the recent increase from \$140 million to \$160 million in available nuclear energy liability insurance and reflects the recent amendment to 10 CFR Part 140, "Financial Protection Requirements and Indemnity Agreements," published by the Commission.

Pursuant to your request, Indemnity Agreement No. D-9, dated January 3, 1966, as amended by Amendment No. 11 thereto and effective as of May 1, 1979, has been reviewed and is accepted by the National Bureau of Standards. A signed copy of the Amendment is enclosed.

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. D-9

AMENDMENT NO. 11

Effective May 1, 1979, Indemnity Agreement No. D-9, between U. S. Department of Commerce and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated January 3, 1966, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Article II, Paragraph 6, is amended by deleting the amount "\$140,000,000" and substituting therefor the amount "\$160,000,000."
