Recently, the United States Civil Service Commission adopted an amendment to the regulation which governs the disclosure of information from official personnel folders (5 CFR 294.702), effective June 24, 1977. The purpose of the amendment was to comply with the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, which mandates that information be made available to "any person" unless such information is subject to one of the exemptions under the Act.

The amended regulation states, in pertinent part:

- "(a) The following information about most present and former Government employees is available to the public:
  - (1) Name:
  - (2) Present and past position titles:
  - (3) Present and past grades:
- (4) Present duty stations (which include room numbers, shop designations or other identifying information regarding buildings or places of employment.)"

Accordingly, we are hereby requesting that you provide, at your earliest convenience, the information set forth in items 1 and 4, above, in connection with all employees currently employed by your agency. Please forward this information to my attention at the above address.
