This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. W. L. Axelson of this office on December 12 and 19, 1978, and January 3, 1979, of activities at the Byron Station, Units 1 and 2 authorized by NRC Construction Permits No. CPPR-130 and No. CPPR-131 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. C. McDonough and others of your staff.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.
