I understand that your Appeal Board  
may still be considering confirming  
VEPCO's North Anna operating license.

I urge you to consider first holding  
a public hearing -- I (we) are concerned  
and affected by what happens at North Anna --  
to make available to all interested persons  
the settlement conditions and risks  
beneath all North Anna buildings.

I also urge that you investigate the  
revocation of VEPCO's North Anna  
Operating License on grounds of withholding

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hazardous settlement information from  
the Atomic Safety Licensing Board.

I do not feel that VEPCO is  
necessarily totally dishonest and  
I feel it is clear that VEPCO  
can not be trusted to think or  
act in the public interest. I hope you  
and your Board can and does.
