On April 23, 1980, we received a Certificate of Disposition of Materials for License No. 37-00862-14. It was stated that all licensed material had been transferred to PPG Industries, Inc. License No. 37-00374-05. Our files indicate that PPG Industries, Barberton, Ohio is not authorized to receive this material, and in a telephone conversation with Mr. Danmer of PPG Industries of Barberton, Ohio, he specified that this material had not been received at Barberton, Ohio. In our letter of June 5, 1980 to Mr. Jack D. Hays of PPG Industries of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, we requested clarification as to whom the source was transferred. Mr. Danmer of PPG Industries in Barberton, Ohio responded and specified in his letter of June 12, 1980 that they had not received the source.

We would appreciate it if Region III would look into the disposition of this source. Please note that License No. 37-00862-14 expired on May 31, 1980.

Gentlemen:

This refers to your Certificate of Disposition dated April 23, 1980. On this form you specified that you had transferred all licensed materials on License No. 37-00862-14 to PPG Industries, Barberton, Ohio, License No. 34-00374-05. We have checked License No. 34-00374-05 and found that the PPG Industries in Barberton, Ohio is not authorized to receive this material.

In a conversation with Mr. Dahmer of PPG Industries in Barberton, Ohio, he specified that he had not received this material and was not authorized to receive it on any of their licenses.

Since PPG Industries in Barberton, Ohio have stated that they have not received the material, we need further clarification as to whom you transferred the cobalt-60 sealed source listed on License No. 37-00862-14.

Reference: Control No. 03575

I have been in contact with Jack D. Hays, Jr. of PPG Industries and also Lea Tremper at your NRC Gaithersburg, MD location concerning Mr. Hay's Certificate of Disposition (4-23-80), statement that all licensed material on License No. 37-00862-14 was transferred to our License No. 34-00374-05. This statement was in error. The confusion here at Barberton, Ohio was related to the fact that an iron-55 x-ray analyzer was added to our License No. 34-00374-05 and was mistakenly thought to be the item at issue (cobalt-60 sealed source).

During my second phone call to Lea Tremper, she shed some light on this confusion by informing me that the cobalt-60 sealed source was licensed to Richard M. Murchak and Leno Bonet of the Glass Division of PPG Industries, Inc. She further stated that the address listed on the License No. 37-00862-14 was Mt. Zion Road, Mt. Zion, Illinois. Lea Tremper stated that she would relay this information to the proper location and attempt to get this confusion rectified. Neither Mr. Hays nor any personnel at PPG, Barberton, Ohio have possession or knowledge of this cobalt-60 sealed source. I believe your request for action on renewal of License No. 37-00862-14, which expires May 31, 1980, should be directed to the appropriate persons and location listed on the License.

I hope this communication will clarify our non-involvement with this cobalt-60 source and license.
