This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. F. Costello of this office on December 14, 1978, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 29-01818-01, 29-01818-02E and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Costello with Mr. R. Fortin of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in a letter dated February 21, 1978. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

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
