On February 25, 1980, Niagara Mohawk submitted a revised combined Security and Safeguard, Contingency Plan. Upon further review, several additional changes are proposed for the Central Alarm Station and Secondary Alarm Station operators responsibilities. These changes provide for a more expeditious implementation of our compensatory measures. Enclosed are five copies of revisions dated March 4, 1980, which reflect these changes.
