Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

On November 17, 1980, a Unit No. 2 fire barrier LCO was generated on two inoperable fire doors in the Diesel Generator Building to allow their repair and return to normal operable status. Unfortunately, due to an unavailability of replacement hardware, needed to repair the doors, the LCO time frame has been exceeded. Fire door DG 125 is presently inoperable due to a worn latching assembly while fire door DG 203 is inoperable due to a worn locking core. Both doors will be returned to normal operability following the receipt of the required replacement hardware.
