The State of California, represented by the California Energy Commission and the California Public Utilities Commission, is an interested State participant in the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station, Units 4 and 5, licensing proceeding. As a participant in these proceedings, we desire to review carefully the Draft Environmental Impact Statement prepared and recently issued by the NRC Staff.
