

This refers to the inspection conducted by Dr. J. Glenn of this office on September 7, 1979, at your facility in Parsippany, New Jersey, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 29-15364-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Dr. Glenn with yourself and Mr. Ronk of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. This also refers to the meeting held at the NRC's License Management Branch Office on September 11, 1979 and attended by yourself and Mr. J. Masefield of Isomedix and by Dr. Glenn of this office, Mr. N. Bassin and P. Guinn of the License Management Branch, and Mr. J. Mezzger of the NRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a review of your progress in decontaminating portions of your facility prior to release of these areas for unrestricted use. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
