Dear Mr. Ballard:

During the meeting with the Missouri Public Service Commission staff, Mr. Fluegge of our staff raised the question of the status of the application for an operating license for Callaway Unit 2.

Attached is a copy of Union Electric Company's letter dated October 19, 1979 submitted to Mr. Harold R. Denton, Director NRR.

The letter indicates that Union Electric Company filed an amendment to its application of April 30, 1974, for two Construction Permits and two Operating Licenses for a nuclear plant designated Callaway Plant, Units 1 and 2.

With respect to Callaway Plant, Unit 2, docket no. STN 50-486, the amended application consisted of the technical information required by 10 CFR 50.34 and identified as the SNUPPS Final Safety Analysis Report and Callaway Plant Site Addendum. In addition, the Environmental Report identified for Unit 1 of the Callaway Plant included information on the environmental effects of the operation of both units. Additional information required to complete the amended application for the issuance of an operating license for Callaway Plant, Unit 2, including supplementation of the general information and environmental report, will be filed at a later date consistent with the scheduled completion of construction of that unit.

The amendment contemplates that the NRC staff will conduct its review through the issuance of a Safety Evaluation Report for Callaway Plant, Units 1 and 2, and an Environmental Impact Statement on Callaway Plant, Unit 1 leading to the issuance of an operating license for Unit 1. Following the later supplement to the operating license application for Unit 2, it is anticipated that an Environmental Impact Statement on Callaway Plant, Unit 2 would be prepared.
