Dear Officer:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. §552, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulations on public records, 10 C.F.R. §§9.4 and 9.8, the California Energy Commission hereby requests a copy of the NRC Staff report and recommendations on the petition for rulemaking filed by the Public Interest Research Group.

The PIRG petition (NRC Docket No. 50-22) requests the NRC to conduct a rulemaking to determine whether to require plant operators to post bonds to be held in escrow, prior to each plant's operation to ensure that funds will be available for proper and adequate isolation of radioactive material upon each plant's decommissioning. The PIRG petition was noticed at 42 Fed.Reg. 40063, on August 8, 1977. NRC Staff has recently informed us that the NRC Secretariat's Number for the Staff report we are requesting is SECY-78-13-C.
