In response to the IE Bulletin No. 79-19: I did not use, transport, or request burial of any radioactive waste under my NRC license (15-16428-01) during 1978 or thus far during 1979. Thus, my answers to the three questions posed in section 9 of IE Bulletin No. 79-19 are: 1) None, 2) None, and 3) No.

Furthermore, I contemplate no further use of radioactive isotopes at the Marine biological laboratory in Maine where I do research during the summers (my license authorizes my use of radioactive isotopes specifically at the Mount Desert Island Biological Laboratory, Salsbury Cove, Maine 04672). I therefore wish to terminate my NRC license, effective immediately. A copy of my license is enclosed.
