We are herewith replying to your letter, Reference (a) with attached appendix A "Notice of Violation".

Please be advised that we have taken the corrective steps as follows:


- (1) The employee in question, - Sun Ship Badge #70-44 received from the 18th through the 25th of August, 1980 a total of 48 hours of classroom training during which he successfully passed written examinations in radiography and radiation safety. His final grades were 85.1 and 82, respectively.
- (2) If an employee is not able to pass the required examination, he will be either demoted in his classification and consequently the type of work he is allowed to do, or dismissed from the department.
- (3) The date, when successfully passed the Radiation Safety Test and hence, full compliance was achieved was August 25, 1980. The examination papers are on file.
