On January 9, 1980, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission held a public meeting dealing with the management competence issue in the TMI-1 proceeding. The meeting centered around a memorandum and draft order prepared by the NRC Office of General Counsel. Copies of these documents are attached.

Although the memorandum and draft order were discussed by the General Counsel and the Commissioners at length, a conclusions were reached.
