Enclosed for your information is the LaSalle County Station Design Assessment Report (DAR), Revision 7. This document supercedes the previously submitted Design Assessment Report, through Revision 6, and the Design Assessment Closure Report. It should be understood that the enclosed document incorporates all the design information contained in previous revisions of the DAR and Closure Report. Existing information was merely reformatted to promote clarity. In this regard, the LaSalle County Station commitments with respect to the Mark II Lead Plant Acceptance Criteria, NUREG-0478 are again clearly delineated. Furthermore, each of the Mark II containment issues identified by the Containment Systems Branch (Mr. C. Anderson) at the meeting of May 11, 1979 has been addressed in this enclosure.

It is judged that all Mark II containment related topics have been addressed in this submittal. It is requested that on the basis of this documentation the Mark II Containment issues identified as open items in the LaSalle County review be closed. If you have any questions in this regard please direct them to this office.
