Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Source Material License No. STC-833, as renewed. The license authorizes possession at any one time of a maximum of fifty (50) pounds of thorium, and processing of not more than fifteen (15) pounds of thorium at any one time.

Please note also that your letter of October 21, 1965, is not incorporated as a condition of this license since the information was not necessary for our evaluation of your application. Your letter of October 21, 1965, is, however, being retained in our files.

Note also that any future applications of a confidential nature should be submitted pursuant to 2.790, 10 CFR 2, "Rules of Practice" (copy enclosed). As provided in this section, any information which you wish withheld should be specifically identified and, as far as possible, incorporated in a separate paper. Also, you should support such requests with information demonstrating why the information is not required in the public interest and how such disclosure would adversely affect the interest of the Corporation.
