To Whom It May Concern: At the September 24, 2019 on-site NRC inspection, it was requested that NRRON LLC provide "Change of Control" answers to the below questions as it relates to Johnson Memorial Hospital, Inc. and Hartford Hospital, Inc.

- 1. Please provide a clear description of the transaction, including the identity and the technical and financial qualifications of the proposed transferee.**

Trinity Health Of New England, Inc. became the parent of Johnson Memorial Hospital effective 10/1/16. All NRRON services, policies and procedures, Member Representatives, Board of Directors, equipment, and staff stayed exactly the same.

Hartford Hospital has been a subsidiary of Hartford HealthCare Corporation for over ten years. All NRRON services, policies and procedures, Member Representatives, Board of Directors, equipment, and staff stayed exactly the same.

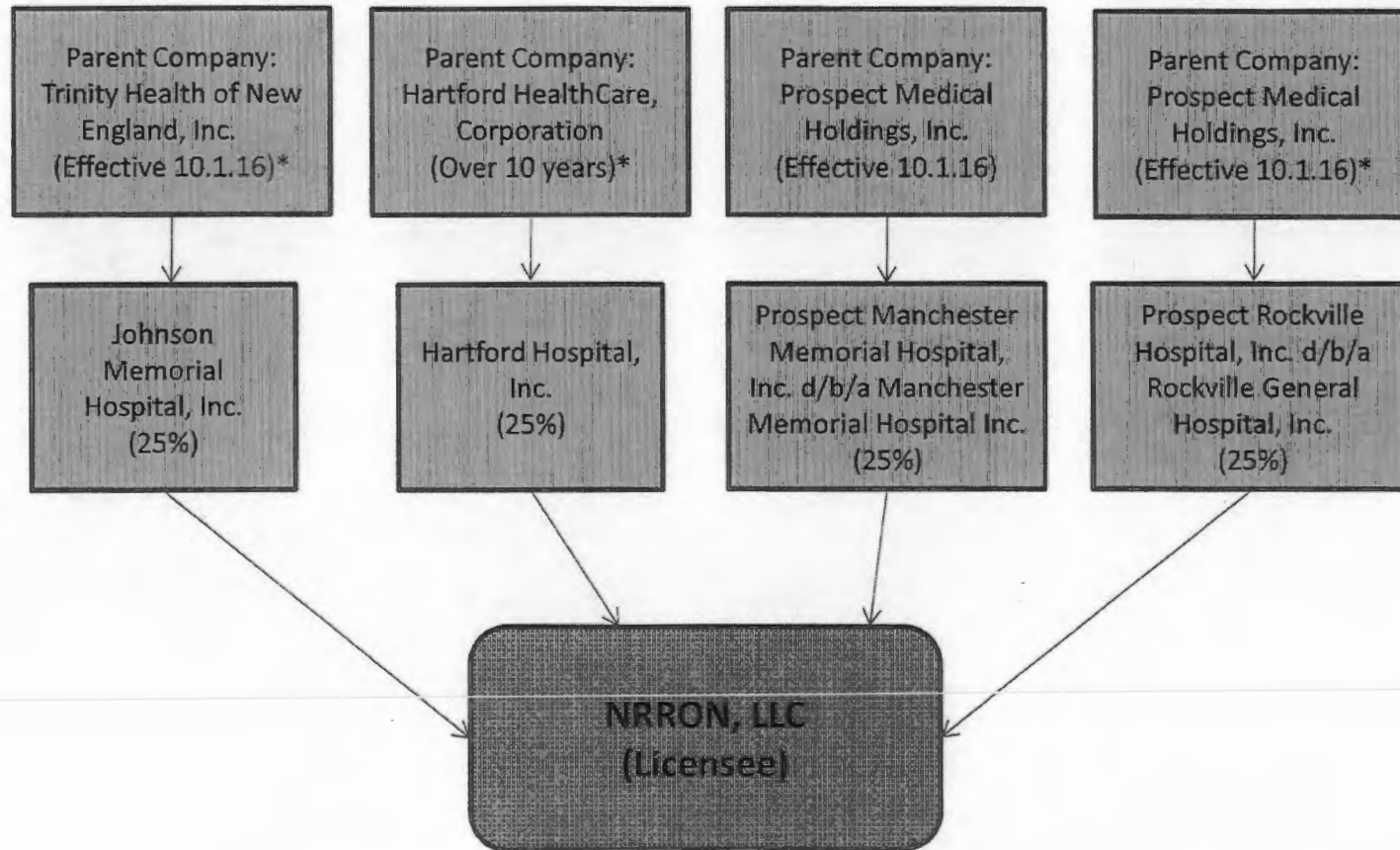
