Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants, Supplement 5, Second Renewal, Regarding Subsequent License Renewal of Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit Nos. 3 and 4, NUREG-1437, Supp. 5, Second Renewal was made available on October 25, 2019, and is available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML19290H346.
