ORDER IMPOSING CIVIL MONETARY PENALTIES (REFERENCE: U.S. NRC INVOICE NO. 384-80)

This is in response to your letter and Order of January 23, 1980 which imposed civil monetary penalties for non-compliances associated with the March 28, 1979 accident at Three Mile Island Unit 2. We are providing herewith a check in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$155,000.00) as payment for fines imposed.

Your January 23, 1980 letter requested additional information on our plans or practices in a number of areas. Preliminary arrangements have been made with the Office of Inspection and Enforcement, Region I, to meet and discuss the details of these matters on March 6, 1980. Additionally, details associated with our responses of December 5, 1979 will be provided. Following that meeting, a supplemental response will be provided for corrective action and schedules for those items not completed.
