1) Corrective Steps Taken and Results Achieved

- a) Discrepant conditions have been corrected.
- b) Affected areas have been inspected.

2) Corrective Steps Taken to Avoid Further Noncompliance

- a) A Job Bulletin has been issued designating Zone IV cleanliness areas and re-emphasizing Zone IV housekeeping practices.
- b) A Safety Bulletin has been issued emphasizing all five (5) zones of cleanliness and employee responsibility for enforcement of restrictions.
- c) Instructions have been provided to subcontractors emphasizing adherence to cleanliness requirements.

3) Date to Achieve Full Compliance

Full compliance was achieved on January 28, 1980.
