This letter supplements Florida Power Corporation's letter of January 11, 1980 concerning the implementation of the NUREG-0578 Lessons Learned Recommendations.

In our January 11, 1980, communication to you, Florida Power Corporation committed to hot leg vents and included, as Attachment 4 to that communication, B&W report entitled "177 High Point Vent Design Criteria".

In addition to the hot leg vents previously committed to, FPC will install a remotely operable reactor vessel head vent at CR-3. The design will be similar to that which was described for the hot leg vents in our January 11, 1980 letter.



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
