Additional Response - Notice of Deviation

A continuous external fence 10' high surrounds the WNP-1/4 site. This fence has twelve (12) manned gates, four (4) of which have twenty-four (24) hour access. The balance are staffed during peak hours. A patrol of the exterior of the perimeter fence is performed approximately every two (2) hours and documented by security personnel in logs. In addition, a foot patrol of the interior portion is performed at approximately the same time intervals by security personnel. A special squad of guards also patrol the interior of the site watching for unusual circumstances.

The basic procedure governing access to storage areas is Field General Construction Procedure #9 entitled "Material Receiving and Storage" which was revised on March 3, 1980 to further clarify storage requirements. A WNP-1/4 Materials Management Instruction establishing control and access to Level C and D storage areas as required by ANSI N45.2.2 has been prepared and implemented by the Manager, Project Materials Management.
