Subject: Environmental Incident No. EI 74-3

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

This telegram is to confirm a conversation between William Ruhlen (Region I-DRO), and J.G. Herbein (TMI Superintendent) at 1103 WTS. 5 June 1974.

Violation of the Environmental Technical Specification 2.2.7.a (page 7) in that the free chlorine component measured at the plant river discharge exceeded .1 ppm and the total chlorine component measured at the plant river discharge exceeded .2 ppm on 5 June 1974.

Analysis of the free chlorine component in the plant river discharge 30 minutes after the start of a chlorination cycle indicated .10 ppm and at 60 minutes after the start of the same chlorination cycle indicated .16 ppm.

Analysis of the total chlorine component in the plant river discharge at 30 minutes and at 60 minutes after the start of a chlorination cycle indicated .30 ppm.
