

Dear Sir:

Your letter dated April 20, 1977 enclosed Amendment 11 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-44 which reflected changes to the 10CFR Part 140, "Financial Protection and Requirements and Indemnity Agreements" which became effective on May 1, 1977. This amendment, in effect, increased from \$125 million to \$140 million in the primary layer of nuclear energy liability insurance provided by Nuclear Energy Liability-Property Insurance Association and Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters.

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-44

AMENDMENT NO. 11

Effective MAY 1 1977, Indemnity Agreement No. B-44, between Duke Power Company, and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated March 24, 1970, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

The amount "\$125,000,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$140,000,000" is substituted therefor.

The amount "\$96,875,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$108,500,000" is substituted therefor.

The amount "\$28,125,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$31,500,000" is substituted therefor.


Item 2a of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:
