Dear Mr. Reid:

On January 20, 1978, Mr. Victor Stello, of your staff, requested of "all PWR licensees" an assessment of the potential for damage of nuclear steam supply system (NSSS) components due to postulated reactor coolant system piping breaks. Toledo Edison has participated jointly with other Babcock & Wilcox NSSS owners and have issued an interim report in response to your request.

This interim generic report is entitled, BAW 1597, "Effects of Asymmetric LOCA Loadings - Phase II Status" and is applicable to the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1 (DB-1). This has been submitted to your staff by letter from Mr. J. H. Taylor of Babcock & Wilcox on February 14, 1980.

This report provides the status of the assessment effort to-date; a final report is scheduled to be submitted no later than July 1, 1980.
