We are in the process of preparing a slide presentation for the Toledo Edison Company and the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, which deals with the proposed Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station for Northeast Ohio. You will note that we have borrowed extensively from AEC material; in particular your speech of November 19, 1970, before the Associated Press Managing Editors' Convention in Honolulu.

We also need six or seven photos showing exterior views of existing nuclear power plants, and photos of a nuclear submarine and nuclear aircraft carrier.


The script also calls for an exterior view of the NASA reactor station near Sandusky, Ohio.
