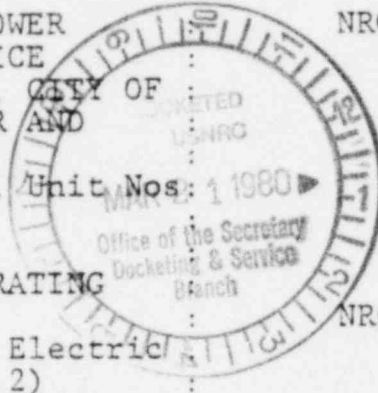

Supplemental Response to Interrogatory 16(b):


Mid-Tex Electric Cooperative and the City of Denton have recently explored their alternatives for power with TU. See the documents attached hereto.
