INFORMATION NOTICE 80-10

Thank you for your letter of March 10, transmitting
IE Information Notice No. 80-10 on the Crystal River Unit 3
Incident.

You may be aware that about a week ago, a report on the
Crystal River Incident by the industry's Nuclear Safety Analysis
Center and Institute for Nuclear Power Operations was transmitted
to the NRC. If you have not received a copy of that report, we
would be pleased to obtain one for you.

Copies of your information notice and the NSAC-INPO report
like all other notices and information of this nature are received
and reviewed by our Nuclear Projects Office staff and by Point Beach
Nuclear Plant supervisory staff. Further action, as appropriate,
will then be taken on the basis of these reviews.

We do not understand your transmittal and the notice which
anticipates that the information will be distributed to "all operational
personnel". If this specific language denotes a particular distri-
bution of IE bulletins and notices that is different from our traditional
and we believe effective practice, your further clarification in this
regard would be appreciated. We would be pleased to discuss this
matter with you during your visit to Point Beach on April 8.
