SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION 030-36174/2019-001 AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Wadsworth:

This letter refers to an inspection conducted on-site January 22, 2019, with an in-office search for your contact information through March 1, 2019, and a Notice of Violation (Notice) that was mailed to you on April 10, 2019, which involved a failure to update the address on your license. The Notice is accessible from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access Management System (ADAMS) Accession ML19107A012.

On June 11, 2019, the NRC received your termination request for New World Environmental, Inc.'s license. The NRC acknowledges that New World Environmental, Inc., no longer has a physical address. The NRC amended your license, Amendment 5, to authorize the license termination on August 19, 2019 (Adams Accession ML19259A103).

The NRC has concluded that information regarding: (1) the reason for the violation; (2) the corrective actions taken, including terminating the license; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved is already adequately addressed on the docket in your termination request. Therefore, you are not required to respond to this letter unless the description herein does not accurately reflect your corrective actions or your position. In that case, or if you choose to provide additional information, you should follow the instructions specified in the Notice.

To the extent possible, your response should not include any personal privacy or proprietary information so that it can be made available to the Public without redaction. If personal or proprietary information is necessary to provide an acceptable response, please provide a bracketed copy of your response that identifies the information that should be protected and a redacted copy of your response that deletes such information. If you request withholding of such information, you must specifically identify the portions of your response that you seek to have withheld and provide in detail the bases for your claim of withholding (e.g., explain why the disclosure of information will create an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy or provide the information required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 2.390(b) to support a request for withholding confidential commercial or financial information).
