SUBJECT: INDUSTRIAL INJURY

One person was injured on March 27, 1980, when the hydraulic operated pedestal crane collapsed in the IB nuclear service water cooling tower. The man was admitted to the Doctor's Hospital, Augusta, Georgia with a fractured right leg, body bruises and facial cuts.

Unit 1 is approximately five percent complete.

No media interest has occurred. Neither Georgia Power Company nor the NRC plans a press release. The State of Georgia and OSHA have been notified. This Preliminary Notification is issued for information only.

Region II (Atlanta) received notification of this occurrence by telephone from Georgia Power Company at 4:15 p.m. on March 27, 1980. This information is current as of 8:00 a.m. on March 28, 1980.

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
