This is to advise you that submittal of the final report for subject deficiency will be delayed one additional month. This delay is because of (1) drawing discrepancies (i.e., required dimensions and machine finish not on drawing) and (2) late delivery of gaskets which are required for reassembly of the pumps after installation of the modification kits required by this deficiency. Ingersoll-Rand has been contacted on the drawing deficiencies and resolution of this item is expected within the next two weeks. The gaskets required for pump reassembly were received on site last week and are currently undergoing receipt inspection.

The new date for submittal of this final report to your office is June 1, 1980, rather than May 1, 1980.
