On April 30, 1980, Mississippi Power and Light Company notified Mr. J. D. Wilcox of your office of a Potentially Reportable Deficiency (PRD) at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) construction site. The deficiency is associated with containment gas analysis systems supplied by Comsip, Inc. This matter was reported by Comsip to the NRC, Region V, pursuant to 10 CFR 21, in their letter of April 3, 1980. That Comsip report detailing the information required by 10 CFR 21.21(b)(3) is attached.

We have determined that this matter constitutes a reportable condition under 10 CFR 50.55(e). Furthermore, we have concluded that this condition is also required to be reported under 10 CFR 21. This letter to you, with attachments, constitutes our required reporting of this matter under both 10 CFR 50.55(e) and 10 CFR 21.

Please advise MP&L of any additional information required. This matter is tracked under Bechtel Management Corrective Action Report - GGNS No. 78 and PRD-80/24. Our final report on PRD-80/24 is attached.
