On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), thank you for your September 26, 2019, letter summarizing the requested updates to the format and content of the report on the status of NRC's licensing activities and regulatory duties. The Commission appreciates the availabity of your staff for follow-up discussions as the NRC staff worked on the revision.

The enclosed report is NRC's first effort to respond to the Committee's requested changes and presents information from the fourth quarter of Fiscal Year 2019 (July 1 – September 30, 2019).
